There is information about upcoming events such as conferences, workshops and networking events.

A number of interesting and relevant publications, articles and reports can be accessed via the WOB website. And various resources to assist aspiring or current board members improve their skills can also be found on the site. WOB offers a number of professional development opportunities, as well as regular webinars for those who are unable to attend their other events.
